How countries in Latin America can work together to face the challenge of decreasing new cases of cervical cancer and saving 28 thousand women* from premature death every year?

In Latin America, cervical cancer is the second most diagnosed cancer in women*.

It affects mainly poorer women with little access to early detection and treatment services.

But, given currently available scientific and technological expertise – cervical cancer is almost completely avoidable!

Cervical cancer reflects social and gender inequalities!

In Latin America there is technological availability and great experience and expertise!

However... this is a Region with <u>extreme</u> heterogeneity in terms of <u>coverage of women</u> by organized programs and applied technologies for diagnosis and treatment.


Extension of the screeening coverage of women within the framework of prevention programs



Timely treatment of women with precancerous lesions and cervical cancer

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


The Technological Platform for Technical Assistance provides virtual, interactive and dynamic tools to comply with the objectives set by each country and develop different strategies...
