In many countries, where people are encouraged or required to stay at home, the risk of intimate partner violence is likely to increase. Please see the following resource for more

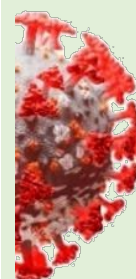
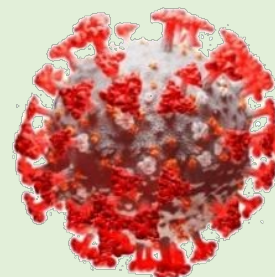

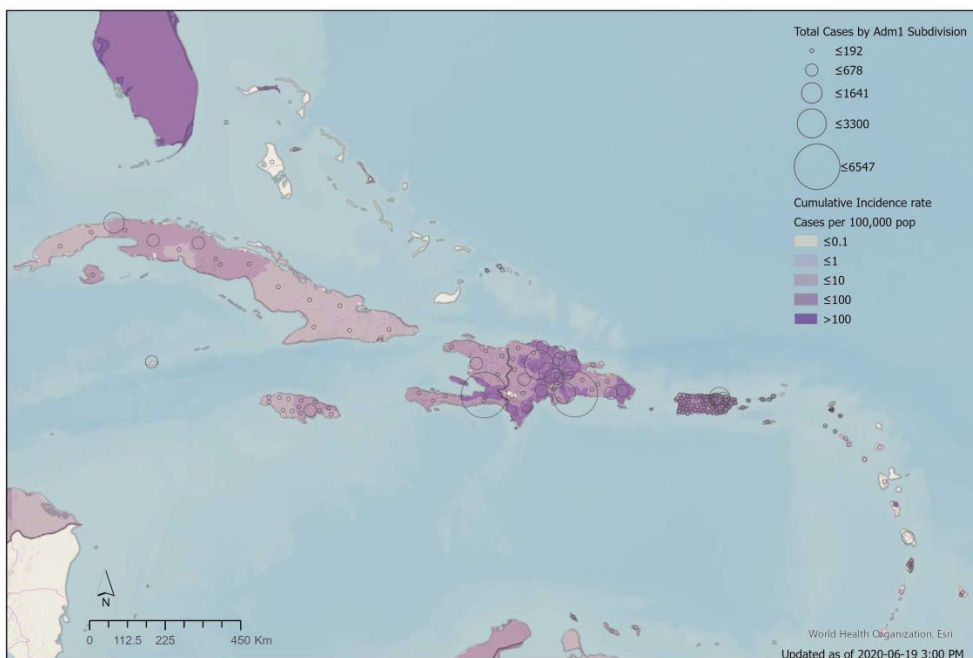

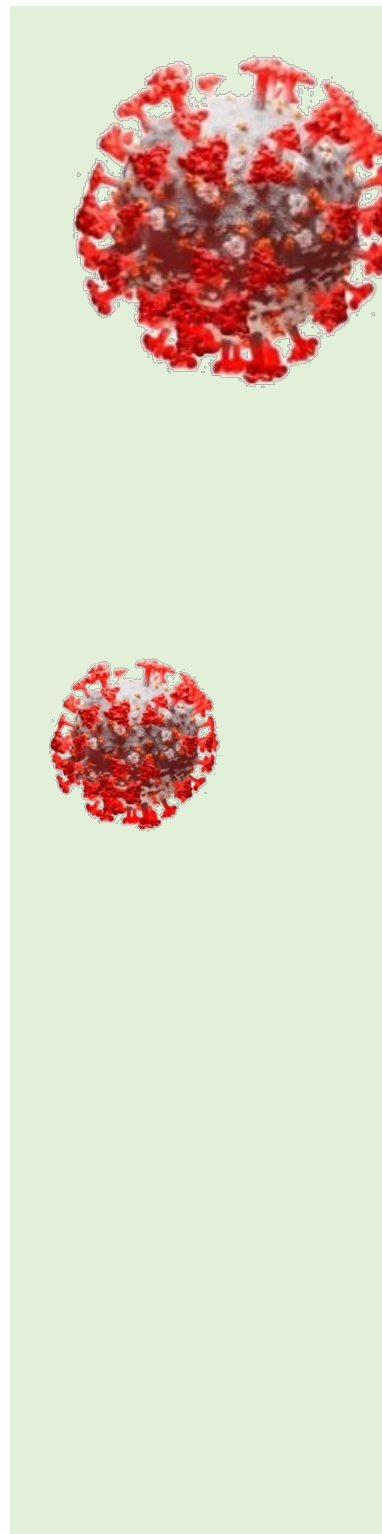
**COVID-19 case update:** French Guiana have a 12% increase compared to the previous day. (see *Table 1* on page 3)

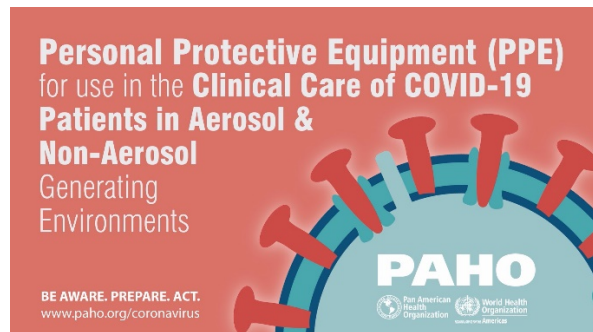
# PAHO's Response

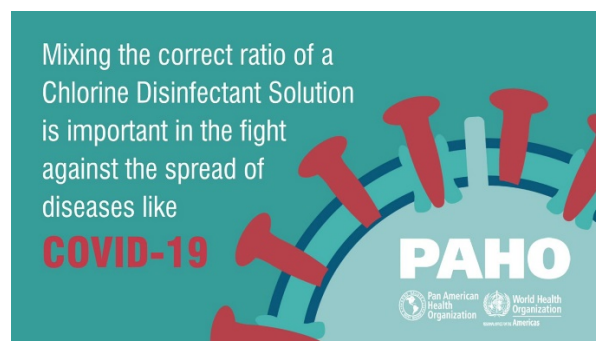
