## PAHO JAMAICA CO EOC - SITUATION REPORT #42

# NOVEL CORONAVIRUS-COVID-2019 - 21 APRIL 2020 (as at 6:00 p.m.)

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

### 1. Jamaica:

- a. Confirmed cases: 233 (10 new)
  - i. 34 imported, 52 contacts of cases, 8 local transmission-not epidemiologically-linked and 139 are under investigation
  - ii. Sex: 89 M (38%) / 144 F (62%)
  - iii. Age: Mean: 34 years / Median: 28 years / Range: 2 87 years
  - iv. N.B. 124 of the confirmed cases are linked to a workplace cluster and are under investigation.
- b. Deaths: 6 (on 18 March, 31 March, 1 April, 7 April, 14 April and 20 April 2020)
- c. Recovered: 27
- d. Isolation: 222 (total)
  - i. 84 in hospital
  - ii. 71 in transition care (step-down) facilities
  - iii. 67 in home isolation
- e. Samples tested: 1,936, with 233 positive, 1,695 negative and 8 pending
- f. Contacts: 2,350 (total), with 844 of these close contacts being followed
- g. Quarantine:
  - i. No. in National Quarantine Facilities: 24

#### 2. Bermuda:

- a. Confirmed cases: 98 (12 new)
  - i. 37 imported, 46 local transmission, 15 under investigation
- b. Deaths: 5
- c. Recovered: 39
- d. Samples tested: 877, with 98 positive, 772 negative, 7 pending
- e. Quarantine (with public health supervision): 209
- f. Self-quarantine: 14 (with public health supervision)
- g. The shelter-in-place order was extended today, for the period 18 April 2020 2 May 2020.

# 3. Cayman Islands:

- a. Confirmed cases: 66 (0 new), with 1 death reported
- b. Recovered: 7
- c. Samples tested: 778, with 66 positive and 712 negative (No new routine results were received on 21 April 2020.)
- d. The shelter-in-place order is in place from 17 April 1 May 2020.

# **SITUATION OVERVIEW**

Jamaica, Bermuda and the Cayman Islands started preparedness for any possible introduction of the novel coronavirus – COVID-19 in early January 2020, immediately following identification of the novel coronavirus on 7 January 2020 in China.

The respective national level Committees / Councils continue to guide all sectors in the required preparedness and response actions.

# **ACTIONS TAKEN:**

#### Jamaica:

- MOHW:

- 1. Additional isolation facilities have been identified to accommodate approximately 200 persons outside of hospital
- 2. Interim guidelines for the management of pregnant women completed and circulated.
- 3. Continue contact tracing, testing and quarantine of MOHW workers who are contacts of a confirmed case at the MOHW Head Office.
- 4. Continue special containment measures for workers and contacts at identified Call Centres.
- 5. Further the planning and guidelines for lock-downs of parishes and possibly the country
- Escalate the identification of cases and contacts, contact tracing, establishment of national quarantine and isolation facilities and installation of equipment and materials for case management.
- 7. Expand community engagement and risk communication for persons in home quarantine and isolation.

#### - PAHO:

- 1. Planning and coordination
  - a. 24-hr technical guidance and support to the MOHW EOC and executive, focusing on coordination of health sector activities, re-organization of the health services, epidemiological surveillance, contact tracing, laboratory and case management.
  - b. Technical lead for COVID-19 response in collaboration with UNCT and International Development Partners
- 2. Resource mobilization
  - a. The PAHO CO SPRP 9-pillar plan and budget were uploaded on the WHO COVID-19 Partners Platform on 21 April 2020.
  - b. The first draft of the proposal for the UN COVID-19 Response and Recovery MPTF was completed and shared with the RC and UNCT on 21 April 2020...
  - c. Planning meetings held with UNCT to further preparation of proposal for UN MPTF-April 18, 19 & 21, 2020
  - d. Preparation of health sector COVID-19 plan and budget by pillars to guide resource mobilization, including for funding by USAID, CDC, USA and EU DEVCO
  - e. Provision of laboratory test kits and PPEs to MOHW.

### Research

- Maintain membership on the Essential National Health Research Committee and provide support to formulate the research agenda for COVID-19, including for early investigations
- 4. Case management and IPC
  - **a.** Technical guidance on case management and IPC, including for a field hospital (EMT SARI), with PAHO Emergency Medical Team section

- 1. Jamaica
  - a. PPEs, laboratory supplies, equipment and supplies for isolation and quarantine wards and rooms
  - b. Go.Data provision of laptops for implementation islandwide being procured
