

Childhood cancer symptoms and signs

1. Sudden or persistent bleeding from nose or gums



2. White pupil or new-onset squint



3. Lumps or swelling (in the neck, armpits or groin)



4. Increased volume of the abdomen



5. Swelling in any part of the body without signs of infection



6. Unexplained bruising



7. Paleness, fatigue, lethargy, changes in behavior



8. Unexplained weight loss or fever, sweating at night



9. Persistent headaches, dizziness, vomiting



10. Bone and joint pain
