## to ensure access to fully-oral treatment for people with drug-resistant TB

Only 1 in 3 people with drug-resistant TB access care. WHO recommends fully-oral treatment regimens to replace injectables. This will improve treatment outcomes and save lives.

# It's time to prevent TB to end TB

1 in 4 people have TB infection. People in close contact with TB patients and those living with HIV are at high risk of developing TB. TB preventive treatment can stop TB infection from turning into disease.

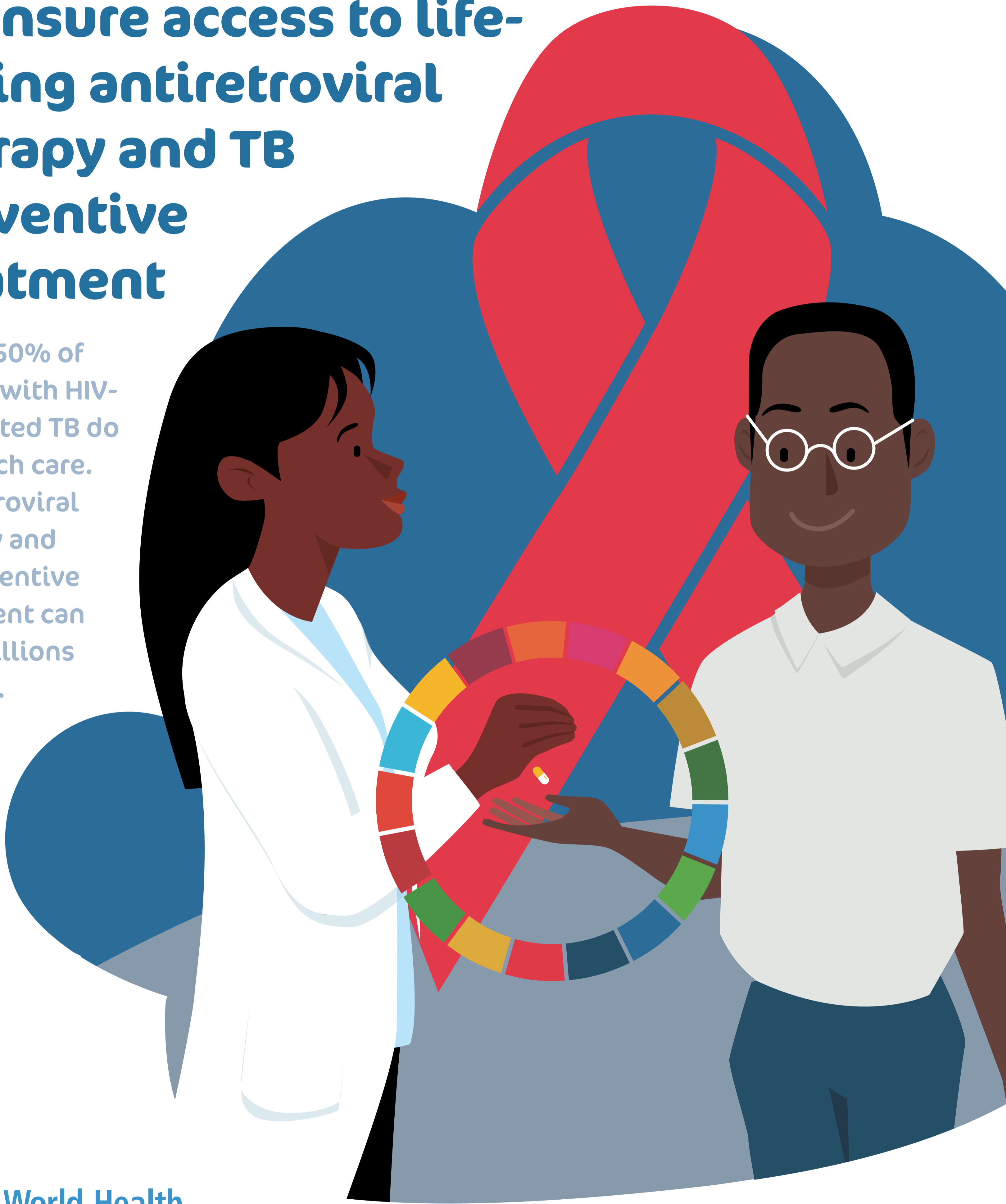




# It's time

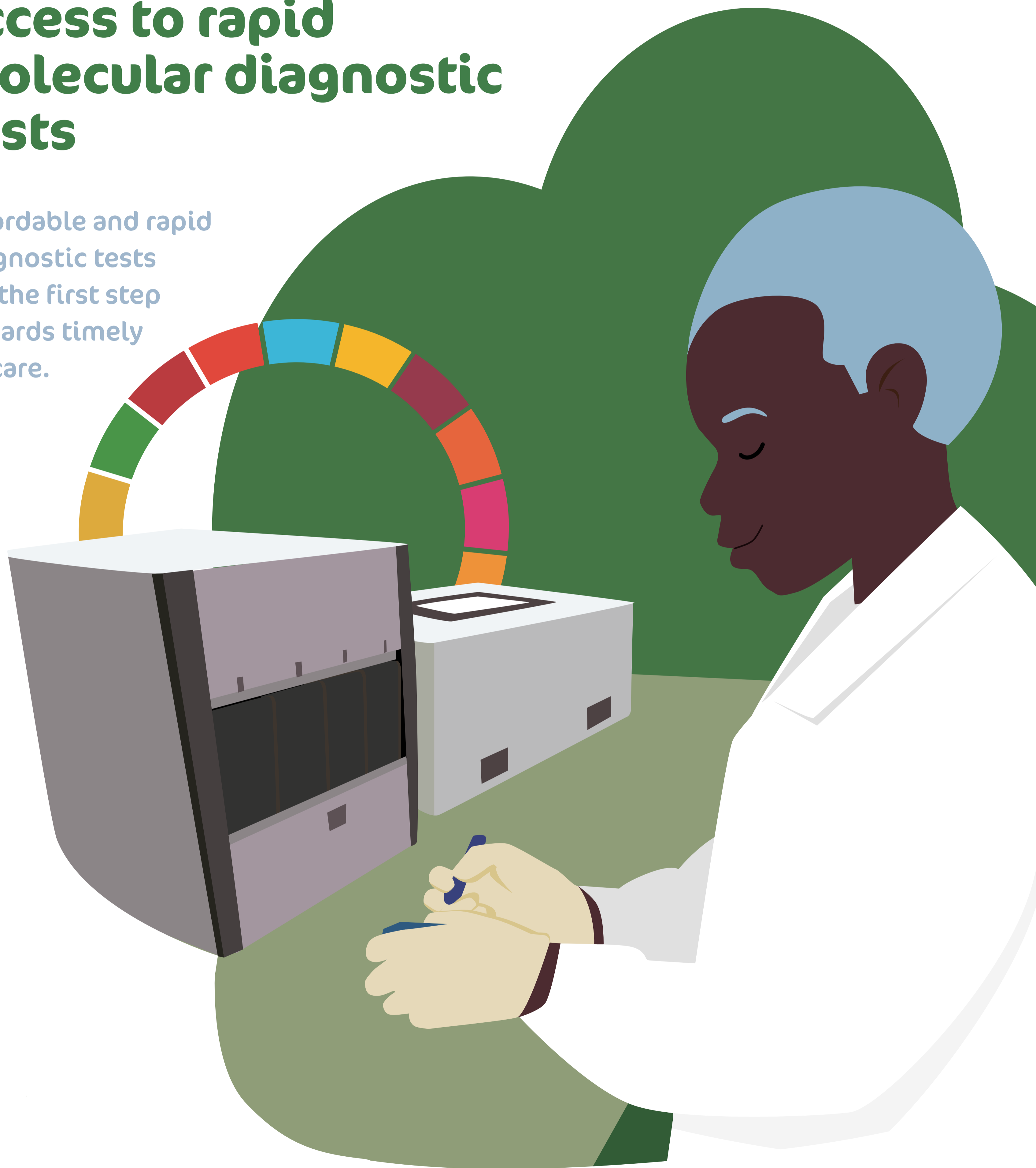

Nurses and health workers play a critical role in TB prevention and care. Enabling them to work to their full potential improves healthcare for all.



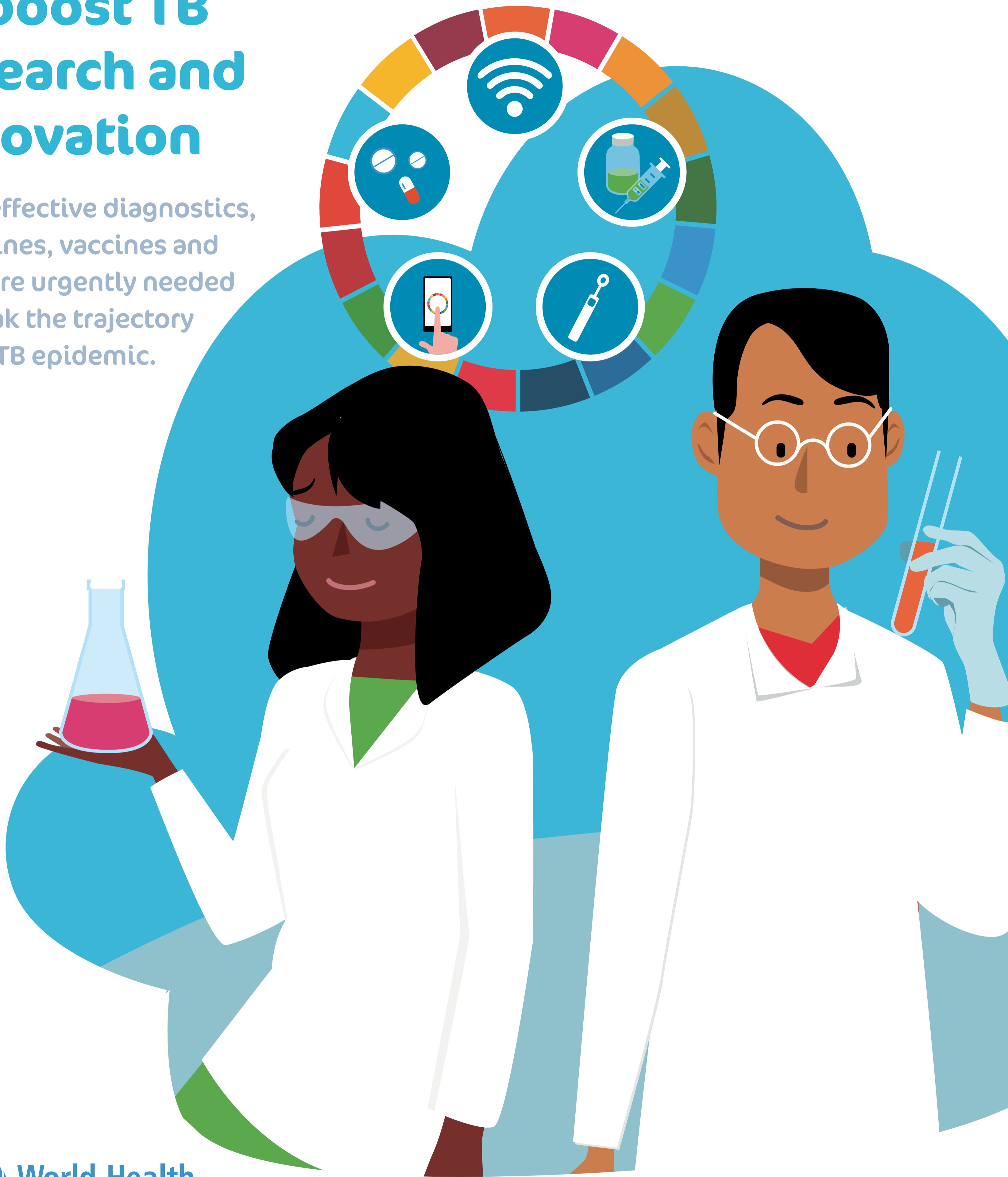
