
This situation update is on the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) reported cases and deaths, Globally, Regionally, for Barbados and Eastern Caribbean Countries, French Territories and the United Kingdom Overseas Territories.

- The COVID-19 pandemic is straining health systems worldwide. The rapidly increasing demand on health facilities and health care workers threatens to leave some health systems overstretched and unable to operate effectively. Previous outbreaks have demonstrated that when health systems are overwhelmed, mortality from vaccine-preventable and other treatable conditions can also increase dramatically.
- ➤ WHO has published <u>guidelines</u> to help countries balance the demands of responding directly to COVID-19, while maintaining essential health services. This includes a set of targeted immediate actions that countries should consider at national, regional, and local level to reorganize and maintain access to high-quality essential health services for all.
- Lifting restrictions too quickly could be as dangerous as lifting restrictions too slowly. The way down can be as dangerous as the way up if not managed properly.







PAHO's Response

In response to the COVID-19 crisis, the Barbados Defense Force (BDF) Emergency Medical Team (EMT) opened a Swabbing Center at the Paragon Base, situated near the Grantley Adams International Airport, in March. Last week, PAHO supported the BDF by providing technical advice and procuring Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) supplies to outfit a second COVID-19 patients triage and swab taking center. Supplies purchased included toilets, sinks, mops, garbage bins and disinfectants.









In 2019, the BDF team was supported by PAHO through a project funded by the Government of Canada and other donors to be classified as EMT, becoming the first team in the Caribbean. On 18 March 2020, PAHO provided the BDF staff with Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs), and have been advising on infection prevention and control measures.
