

The updated clinical management guidance

Some key changes concern:

• Discharge of COVID-19 patients:

- For symptomatic patients: 10 days after symptom onset, plus at least 3 days without symptoms (without fever and respiratory symptoms);
- For asymptomatic patients: 10 days after test positive;
- (Note: the guidance does not longer recommend two negative PCR tests 24 hours for hospital discharge of a recovered patient, as there are reports that patients can remain consistently polymerase chain reaction (PCR) positive for many weeks, or even test PCR positive after days/weeks of a negative test.)
- Treatment of acute co-infections: Use of antibiotic therapy or prophylaxis is not recommended for suspected or confirmed mild COVID-19 patients, and antibiotics should not be prescribed for suspected or confirmed moderate COVID-19 cases, unless there is clinical suspicion of a bacterial infection.
- **Prevention of complications:** Use pharmacological prophylaxis is recommended for adults and adolescents hospitalized with COVID-19, to prevent venous thromboembolism, when not contraindicated.
- Antivirals, immunomodulators and other adjunctive therapies: WHO recommends that the listed drugs not be administered as treatment or prophylaxis for COVID-19, outside the context of clinical trials.
- Corticosteroids and COVID-19: WHO recommends against the routine use of systemic corticosteroids for treatment of viral pneumonia.




