ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER STATES TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE EXPIRATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF ARGENTINA, THE PLURINATIONAL STATE OF BOLIVIA, AND JAMAICA

The 61st Directing Council,

Bearing in mind the provision of Articles 9.B and 15.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization;

Considering that Brazil, Colombia, and El Salvador were elected to serve on the Executive Committee upon the expiration of the periods of office of Argentina, the Plurinational State of Bolivia, and Jamaica,

Resolves:

1. To declare Brazil, Colombia, and El Salvador elected to membership on the Executive Committee for a period of three years.
2. To thank Argentina, the Plurinational State of Bolivia, and Jamaica for the services rendered to the Organization during the past three years by their delegates on the Executive Committee.
