


Low-Hanging Fruit in Tobacco Tax Administration

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Ultimate Goal



High-hanging fruit

Strong governance

- Policies have to be fully implemented
- Policies have to be enforced
- Illicit/Illegal activity needs significant repercussions

Secure supply chain

- Functioning, independent Track & Trace system
- Sophisticated tax stamp system
 - Unique identifiers, counterfeit protection



Context


- Why not go right for a Track & Trace system
 - There might not be political will
 - There might not be the infrastructure to support it
 - The tobacco industry solution
 - The problem with moving too fast

■ None ■ Ad valorem ■ Specific


91% of countries in the Region have a uniform excise tax system.



Where do we go?




Low-Hanging Fruit

- Tax Stamps (simple ones)
- Country-specific Health Warning Labels
- Licensing of the supply chain
- Vendor licensing
- Brand tracking
- Improved governance
- Better implementation and enforcement



Tax Stamps

- Why does this matter?
 - Knowing what is inside and outside of the system (enforcement)
 - Increasing barriers and reducing opportunities









Country-specific Health Warning Labels

- Why does this matter?
 - Highly cost-effective intervention
 - Helps to define what is inside and outside of the system (enforcement)










Licensing

- Goals
 - Supply chain control
 - Identification & monitoring
 - Tax collection (maximize) & evasion (minimize)
 - Enforcement (licensing fees can cover these expenses)
 - Restrict availability
 - Increase costs, prices and revenues



Supply Chain Licensing


- Extends beyond just the retailer
- License everyone engaged in the industry
 - Producers/Growers
 - Wholesalers/Distributors
 - Importers/exporters
 - Equipment producers/suppliers





Vendor Licensing

- License the vendor/retailer
- Helps with effective tax collection by reducing avenues for evasion
- Helps with enforcement
- Restricting availability
 - Limit the types of businesses that can sell tobacco
 - Limit the location of businesses
 - Limit the vendor density






Brand Tracking

- Beyond licensing the supply chain and retailers
- Brand licensing fees can reduce brand proliferation
- Single presentation policies (Uruguay) can help reduce the number of brand variants
- At a minimum:

Countries should keep a list of legal brands

- Helps to define what is inside and outside of the legal system





Governance

- Better systems
 - Providing domain/authority, simplifying the systems
 - Communicating with neighboring countries
- Stronger implementation and enforcement of current policies
 - Increased resources for enforcement
 - Swift, severe financial penalties (offset resources needed)
 - Suspension or revoking of licenses
 - Further administrative sanctions (e.g., property seizure)
 - Judicial support to prosecute perpetrators
