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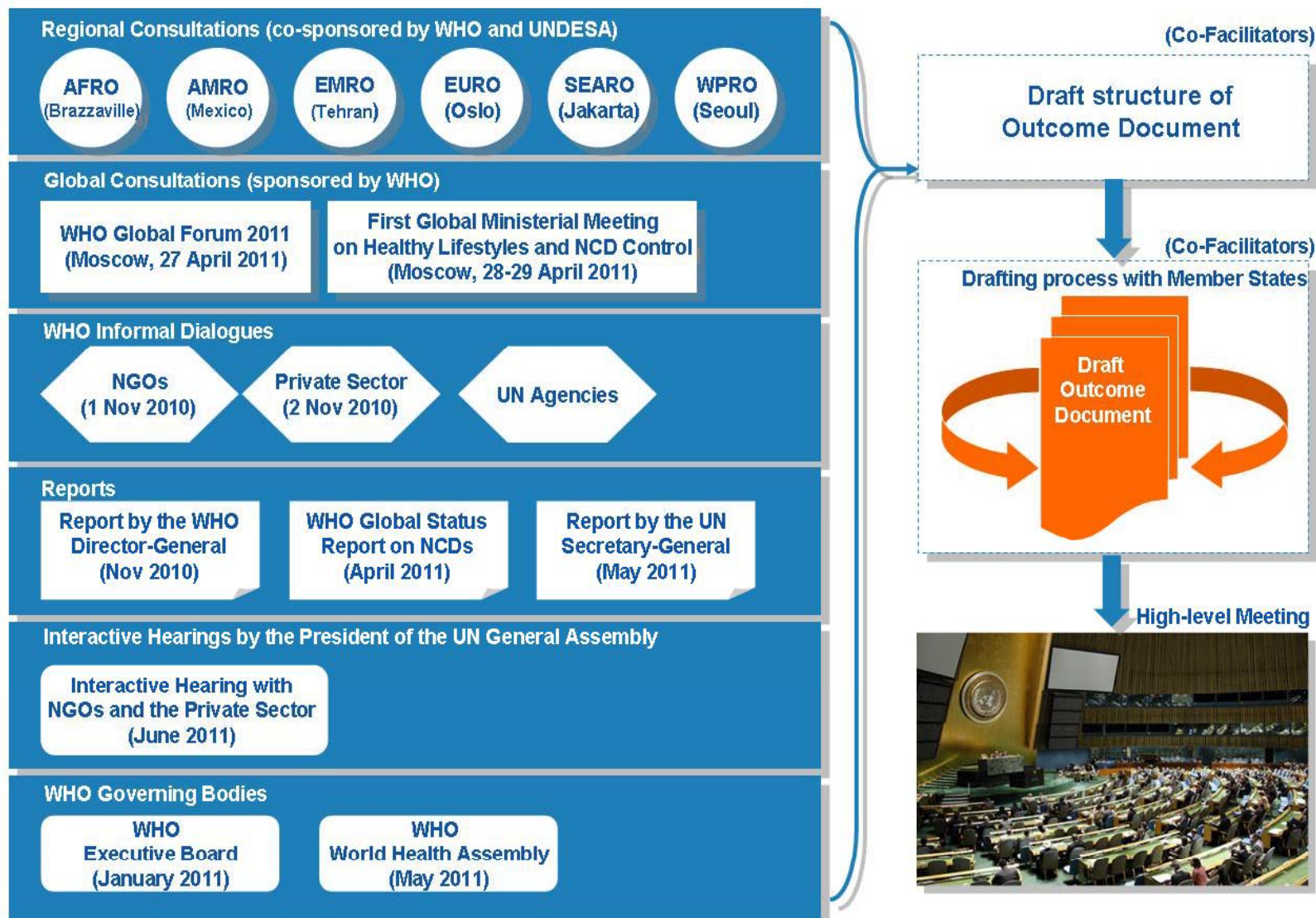




The UN High Level Meeting on NCDs

Outcome	Outcome Document ("We, Heads of State and Government, commit ourselves to ...")

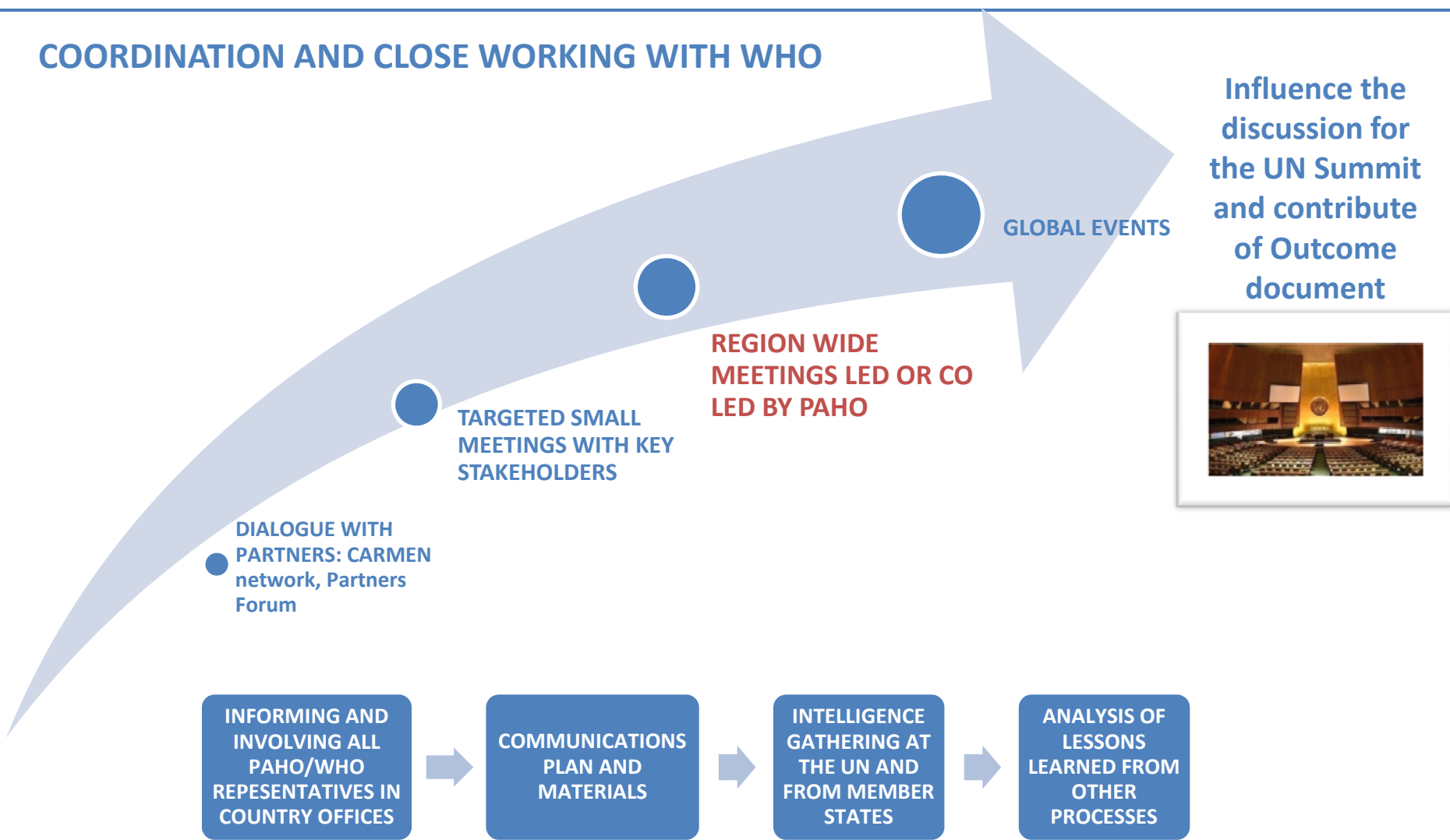

Civil society groups can ask for a meeting with their President/Cabinet
- **Support countries in the negotiation process of the Outcome Document**
- **Support countries in In-country preparation and multi-stakeholder workshops/meetings/consultations as needed**

- Engagement of the UN system; UN ECLAC/PAHO will start program of work on “Economic Dimensions of NCDs”

- Finish building our new instrument of multi-stakeholder collaboration Partners Forum(PF);

- Start preparing for 2012:
 - G-8 in USA, G-20 in Mexico, Summit of the Americas, Latin American Economic Summit
 - Helping countries to develop their plans for implementing post summit action
